- CPCB-II is the next level of emission norms after CPCB-I mandating significant reduction in engine exhaust emissions for diesel generators
- Compared to CPCB-I, the allowable levels of nitrogen oxide (NOx) and particulate matter (PM) — the two main pollutants in diesel engines have been reduced significantly in CPCB-II
- CPCB-II norms are in general similar to EU Stage-III-A (European Union) and US-EPA-Tier-3 (United States Environment Protection Agency) norms. The difference between EU Stage IIIA and CPCB is that EU III A is applicable for rental (mobile) gensets upto 500 KVA only. As against that **CPCB-II are applicable to all Diesel Gensets (Stationary as well as mobile) in India upto 800 kW (1000 kVA)**
